Exodus: God Rescues to Make Himself Known Exodus 33:11 – 34:9 (ESV)

¹²Moses said to the LORD, "See, you say to me, 'Bring up this people,' but You have not let me know whom You will send with me. Yet you have said, 'I know you by name, and you have also found favor in My sight.' 13 Now therefore, if I have found favor in Your sight, please show me now Your ways, that I may know You in order to find favor in your sight. Consider too that this nation is Your people. ¹⁴And He said: "My presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." 15 And he said to him, "If Your presence will not go with me, do not bring us up from here. ¹⁶For how shall it be known that I have found favor in Your sight, I and Your people? Is it not in your going with us, so that we are distinct, I and your people, from every other people on the face of the earth?" ¹⁷And the Lord said to Moses, "This very thing that you have spoken I will do, for you have found favor in My sight, and I know you by name."

¹⁸Moses said: "Please show me Your glory" ¹⁹And He said, "I will make all My goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you My name 'The LORD.' And I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy. ²⁰But, He said, "you cannot see My face, for man shall not see Me and live." ²¹And the Lord said, "Behold, there is a place by me where you shall stand on the rock, ²²and while My glory passes by I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and I will cover you with My hand until I have passed by. ²³Then I will take away My hand, and you shall see My back, but My face shall not be seen."

^{34:1}The LORD said to Moses, "Cut for yourself two tablets of stone like the first, and I will write on the tablets the words that were on the first tablets, which you broke. ²Be ready by the morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai, and present yourself there to Me on the top of the mountain. ³No one shall come up with you, and let no one be seen throughout all the mountain. Let no flocks or herds graze opposite that mountain." ⁴So Moses cut two tablets of stone like the first. And he rose early in the morning and went up on Mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand two tablets of stone. ⁵The LORD descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the Lord ⁶The LORD passed before him and proclaimed:

"The LORD, the LORD, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness, *keeping steadfast love for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but who will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children and the children's children, to the third and the fourth generations."

⁸And Moses quickly bowed his head toward the earth and worshipped. ⁹And he said, "If now I have found favor in Your sight, O Lord, please let the Lord go in the midst of us, for it is a stiff-necked people, and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for Your inheritance."

"At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another. ⁴But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, ⁵He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, ⁶whom He poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, ⁷so that, having been justified by His grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.
